## **Articles of Association**

---

Articles of Association of the undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Association do hereby certify:

### **Article I**

The name of the Association is: Coppel High School Volleyball Booster Club.

### **Article II**

The principle office of the Association is located in the City of Coppel, Texas.

### **Article III**

The period of its duration is perpetual.

### **Article IV**

The Association is organized exclusively for charitable, and educational, including such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The purpose of this Association is to be of service to the Coppel High School Volleyball Team. The Association will work in cooperation with school officials to promote the team achievements, to support them financially, and to help them achieve their goals as set forth by the CHS Athletic Director, CHS head volleyball coach or staff, and volleyball booster officers.

### **Article V**

The names and addresses of the persons who shall serve as directors of the Association until their successors have been elected and qualified, are as follows:

#### **Article VI**

No part of the net earnings of the Organization shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons except that the Organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Organization shall not participate in or intervene in (including publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation/organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future tax code, or (b) by a corporation/organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### **Article VII**

These Articles of Association may be amended from time to time as provided by the statute of the bylaws of the association; provided, however, that no amendment shall be made which would alter the purpose for which the association is organized as set forth in Article IV, or would cause any benefit to inure to any officer, director, incorporator, or member.

#### **Article VIII**

Upon the dissolution of the Organization assets shall be distributed for one (1) or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of common pleas of the county in which the principal office of the Organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
